It's a great time to meet the many new members that have joined us at the Glen over the last 2 years.

This used to be an annual event – and it could be so once again if enough of us participate. There is no cost to take part (except for what you might spend buying your neighbors' treasures).

To keep it simple and sustainable, there are a few rules:

– NO EARLY BIRDS means no sales before 9am.

– Anything and everything that can be legally sold in Washington State without special licenses or permits can be offered for sale at your Glen lot.

– The Glen Community Association is not responsible for the quality, durability or performance of any items offered or sold at this event and does not endorse or otherwise recommend same. All buyer and seller participants acknowledge and accept these conditions and limitations.

– After the sale, DO NOT schlep your unsaleable items to the Glen garbage disposal area – you know, the "MALL". If you bring anything from home or from elsewhere outside the Glen and it doesn't sell, you must keep it or return it to home. We all pay by weight and volume for the trash we leave at the Glen. Help us keep trash disposal costs affordable by honoring this simple rule.

– Canadians may not legally sell items in the US that they bring across the border for this purpose. All such goods crossing the border should be for their own use and consumption.

While you're out touring the Glen, don't forget to stop and treat yourself to our CCC's ICE CREAM AND STRAWBERRIES at the Booknook from 10am while supplies last. Our CCC volunteers sell out every year and for good reason. Edaleen Dairy cows are udderly proud to produce some of the finest ice cream in the state. And Washington farmers bring us some of the best strawberries anywhere. At \$2.00 per serving, there's no better treat anywhere.
